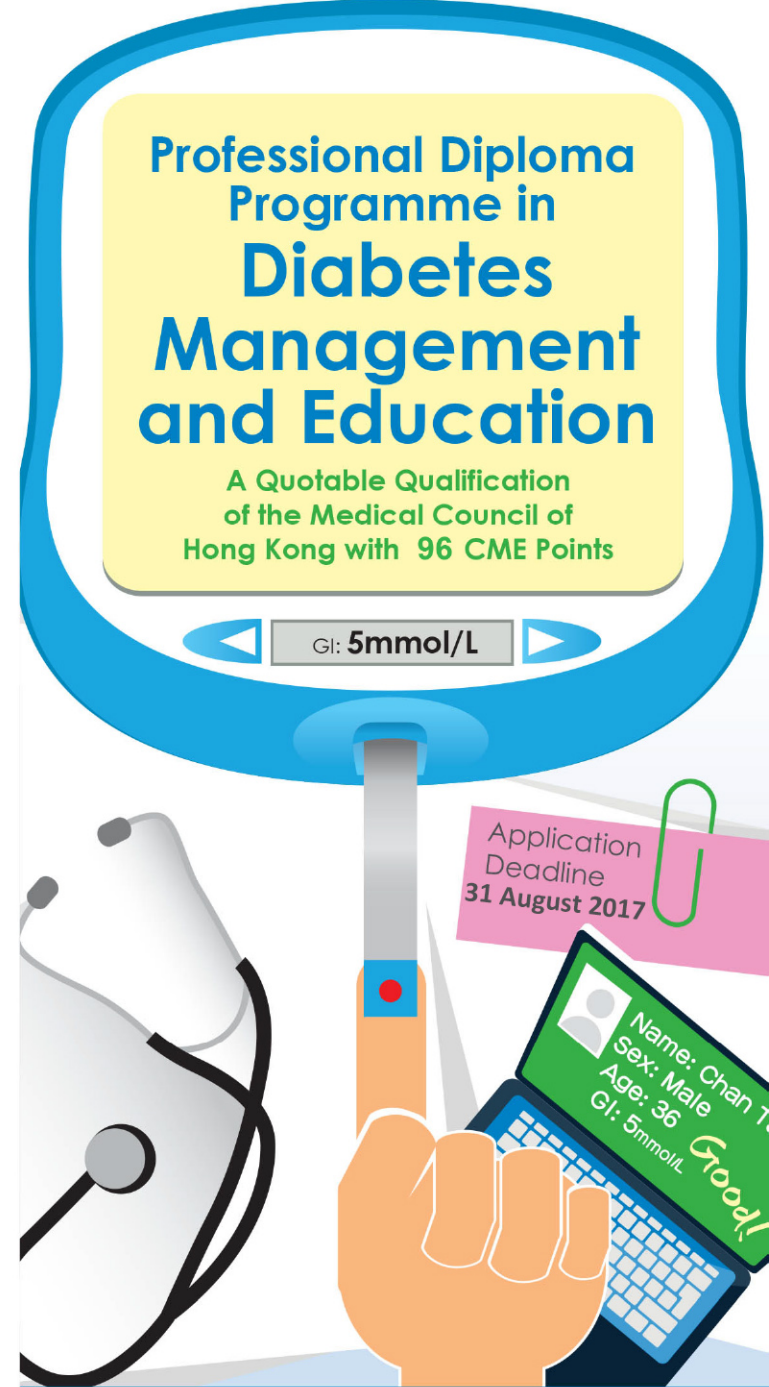

Assessment Methods

Candidates will be awarded a diploma qualification upon satisfactorily fulfilling ALL of the following requirements:

1. 75% Attendance in each module
2. Pass a multiple choice exam paper
3. Pass 4 discussion papers on diagnosis and management of diabetes and related diseases
4. Pass a 5000-word dissertation on a diabetes-related topic

For items 2-4, overall achievement will be graded from A to F with grade C or above being regarded as a pass.
